REGULATIONS RELATING TO PERISHABLE FOODSTUFFS

The Minister of National Health and Population Development has, in terms of section 15(1) of the Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants Act, 1972 (Act No. 54 of 1972), made the regulations contained in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Definition

1. In these regulations "the Act" means the Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants Act, 1972 (Act No. 54 of 1972), and any expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall bear such meaning.

Declaration of certain perishable foodstuffs

- 2. The following foods tuffs are hereby declared to be perishable foodstuffs for the purposes of section 21(2)(a) of the Act:
 - (a) Milk;
 - (b) meat;
 - (c) fish, fish spawn, molluses and crustaceans;
 - (d) fruit;
 - (e) vegetables:

Provided that any of the above foodstuffs or any manufactured product which has undergone a process or processes to extend the shelf-life or improve its keeping qualities and which, for the sake of ensuring its keeping qualities, has to be refrigerated shall also be considered a perishable foodstuff for the purpose of these regulations.
